

WHICH FILTER FOR YOU?



OTHER WHEEL FILTERS

(Red, although colour depends on supplier)

Use for pharmaceuticals. Removes most particles and reduces risk of particles lodging in your system.



BACTERIAL WHEEL FILTER

(Blue, although colour depends on supplier)
Reduces chance of a dirty hit. Greatly reduces the risk of bacteria and particles entering your system. Use for methadone or for pharmaceuticals after filtering particles. Sterile in package.

STERIFILT® FILTER

For use with powders and pharmaceuticals, reduces chance of particles lodging in your system. Reduces chance of dirty hit. Sterile in package.



COMPRESSED COTTON FILTERS

Less likely to block your needle than other cotton based items. Not sterile.



COTTON WOOL BALL

At risk of contamination if rolling with unclean hands. Often does not come in sterile packages.



TAMPON

At risk of contamination if rolling with unclean hands. Same risk level as cotton balls. Sterile until opened.



ALCOHOL SWAB

Chance of blunting needle. Allow alcohol to dry before using as a filter.



UNUSED "ROLLIE" FILTER

Preferable to cigarette filters.



UNUSED CIGARETTE FILTER

Some cigarette filters may contain harmful chemicals and small fibres and are not sterile.

NO FILTER?

All bacteria and particles will remain in your mix. Can lead to vein damage, abscesses, endocarditis and other health concerns. More likely to get a "dirty shot".

Always wash your hands thoroughly before filtering your shot. Use a filter only once - and then throw it away
