
Learn how to save a life.

Do you know what an opioid (heroin, methadone, bupe, oxys, fentanyl) overdose looks like?

- Slow, shallow, strange or no breathing.
- Lips and fingertips turn blue (if light-skinned) or greyish (if dark-skinned).
- Unusual snoring sounds (gurgling, choking).
- Can't be woken or can't stay awake if you pinch their ear and call their name.
